

## STEM Cloud Activity



Using a straw and some cotton balls, teach your child how to blow the cotton balls.

Once they've mastered how to blow out and direct the air flow to move the cotton balls, start measuring the distances they are able to travel.

Use a ruler or even a piece of Painter's Tape to mark their path.

Does your child like games? Set up a friendly competition to see who's cotton ball can travel the farthest.

Talk about how the wind blows the clouds. Go outside and observe the direction of the wind, the strength of the wind and the speed and distance that the clouds move in.
