



No need to brave the store to plant your own flowers! Seeds can be found outdoors in flowers that have gone by- simply “Dead Head” them by snapping of last year’s blooms, and replant them in soil found outside your home.

If using a plastic container to start plants indoors, be sure to poke some drainage holes in the bottom, and use the plastic lid as a saucer to prevent leakage.
